(57) Abstract :

ABSTRACT The invention discloses an Indian medicinal herb as an exfoliating scrub containing grinded Punica granatum L. seeds as an exfoliating agent. The scrub formulation provided by the invention utilizes the grinded seeds as the main raw material along with others and possess the effects of softening epidermal keratinocytes, dredging the pores, improving rough and dark skin, nourishing the skin, changing the color of skin and the like. The main constituents of the exfoliating scrub are the seeds and herbal extract with the effects of skin protection and beauty maintenance. The prepared herbal scrub is an ideal formulation which is suitable for various skins due to the fact that the exfoliating action is achieved by grinded Punica granatum L. seeds, also the preparation is free from side effect(s) after being utilized.
