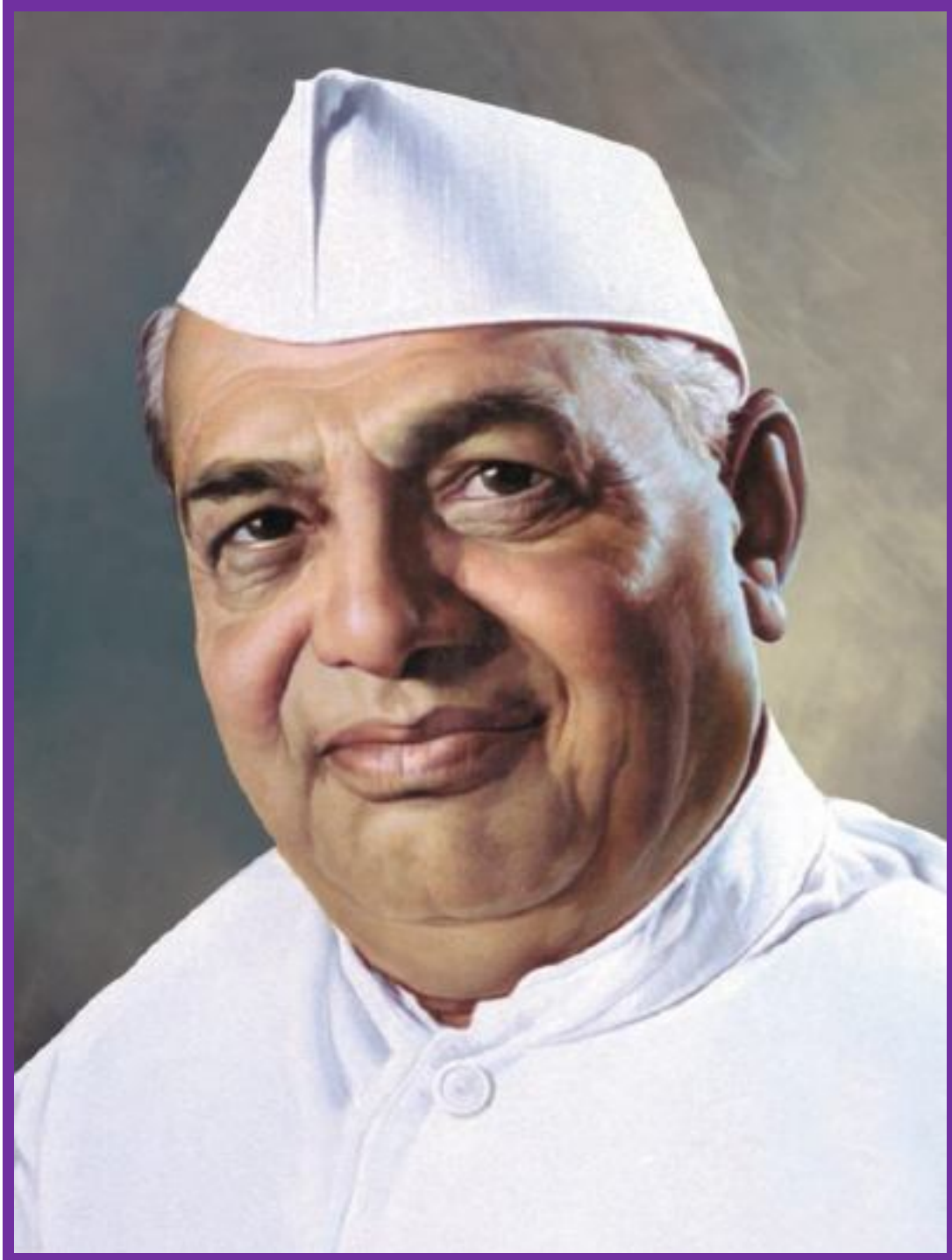

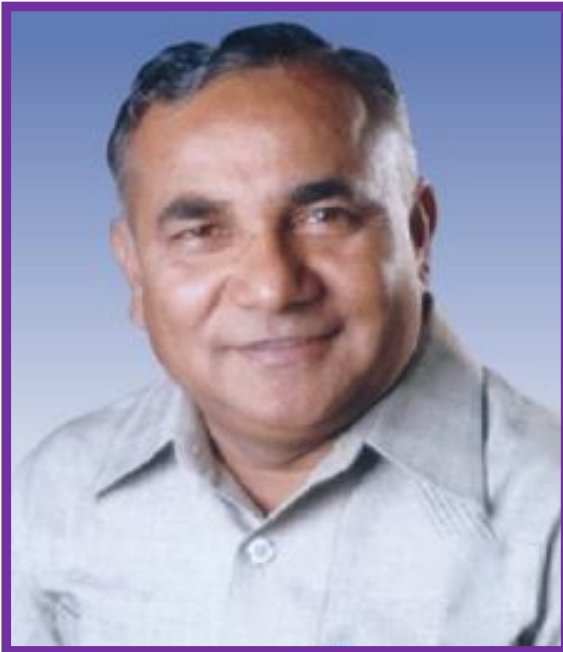

Best Practices:

1. College is using the facility of online Learning Management system which is one of the best innovative and transformative digital learning platform for students and teachers and empowering greater efficiency and customization of the entire learning experience from a single access point
2. Conventional teaching method of 'chalk and talk' is shifted to LCD - based classroom teaching. This allowed more scope and time for interaction with students, rather than developing the concepts on the blackboard. In a few subjects, the traditional method of teaching is continued as in mathematics, pharmaceutical chemistry, pharmacognosy etc. The students are trained with information system based interactions using the software on genomics and simulation software on pharmacology experiments.
3. Faculty encourages the students to get experience in answering MCQ type of questions. This is beyond the curriculum and being implemented, so as to train the students for competitive exams, GPAT etc.
4. Notices, Assignments; Deadlines etc. are communicated to the students via multimedia like email, whatsapp group etc thereby making communication very prompt.
5. Teachers are involved in developing their own videos or animations to explain the concept more clearly.
6. The online Learning Management system has been made very student friendly wherein all the information, notes, past question papers etc. are made available to the students via their individual logins.
7. Assessment of students is done by the means of online class tests and quizzes under VM Edulife platform.
8. As a part of our continuous efforts to groom our students, students are encouraged to take up a research project. The findings of their research are then published in a journal.
9. The faculties have compiled important videos and animations regarding the concepts related to the syllabus of every subject which are made available to the students in the computer lab.
10. WiFi facility is provided in college.
11. **100 Mbps** uninterrupted internet facility is made available.
12. Hostel facility provided for the girls give them homely atmosphere.
13. Book bank facility is provided
14. Laboratories with highly sophisticated instruments
